LA Tech reserves the right to reproduce submitted images for all media and publicity purposes.

Submissions:

- No more than 5 entries are allowed.
- Submission fee is \$5.00
- Application materials must be received online via http://artlatech.slideroom.com no later than 11.59 pm on Monday, February 9, 2015.
- Communication regarding acceptance to the exhibition will be via email. Please do not call or email for acceptance updates.

- Suggested image settings for best possible quality and ease of viewing for juror:
 - .jpg file format

- sRGB color profile
- 1024 x 768 pixels for image files
- 72 ppi resolution
- image submissions should not be larger than 5 mb per file

Delivery and Pick-up:

Accepted works MUST be hand delivered to the gallery by March 17 between the hours of 8 am - 4.30 pm. Two Dimensional work should be matted and framed where appropriate, and wired to be "ready to hang." If work is not properly prepared for installation, it will not be included in the show.

Students MUST pick-up their work between April 15 - 16 during the gallery's normal operating hours. Any work not picked up by these dates will be discarded.
